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Madang Resort

The Madang Resort is the most historic hotel in PNG and one of the famous hotels of the Pacific Region. Initially it served as a guesthouse in the German colonial days, then as a small hotel up until WW2. After WW2 it was owned by several colourful characters and finally acquired by the Barter Family who have owned it since 1976. After WW2 the Hotel Madang faced Coronation Avenue but, with the acquisition of additional land the Hotel was turned 180 degrees to face Dallman Passage and the magnificent Madang Harbour Lagoon. In more recent years Forum Park and Lagoon was reclaimed, providing additional frontage onto Yamilon Lagoon. The total property covers an area of 5 acres, but together with Kalibobo Village, the land area covers 9 acres along 1.5km of spectacular deep-water frontage.

The Madang Resort is located just 500m from downtown Madang, 500m from the 9 hole golf course and 6km from Madang Airport in a gated, secure area where guests can enjoy themselves in a beautiful landscaped environment conducive to relaxation, or to meet with friends and enjoy the many facilities and attractions the Resort and Madang offer the visitor.

The Resort's facilities include a new, well equipped air-conditioned gymnasium, 4 pools including an Olympic sized salt water pool, tennis court, marina, PADI dive shop, gift shop, hair salon, Explorer Bar with extensive library, business centre, bird aviaries, barramundi fish ponds, helipad, giant salt water aquariums stocked with live coral and sea life, five conference rooms

with total capacity of 450 people, the Kalibobo Haus Kibung; a dedicated function room, the Haus Win and Janek Aben Restaurant and Wi-Fi throughout. Video conference facilities are also available.

To further enhance the existing accommodation a new Garden Wing is under construction, along with a major upgrade for the Sana Convention Centre, both are due to be open for the APEC Meeting, scheduled for 2017.

Madang Resort Hotel offers 110 guest suites ranging from standard to presidential, all with satellite LCD/LED television, bathroom, radio, tea and coffee making facilities, fridges, private balconies; most of which overlook the Madang Harbour and gardens. In addition to rooms at the Madang Resort; Kalibobo Village offers an additional 60 suites, 10 cottages and 7 townhouses in an adjacent gated property.

Electric buggies provide fast and convenient means of transport within the grounds of the Resort and Kalibobo Village upon request.

Sightseeing tours and harbour cruises are available daily. There are kayaks, sailing catamarans, push bikes, Avis rental cars available and the Resort has its own Game Fishing Boat available for Game Fishing, scuba diving and snorkeling adventures.

The *Kalibobo Spirit* operates expeditionary private charters from Madang Resort to the Sepik River, Islands in the Bismarck Sea and is fully equipped for scuba diving and snorkeling.



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
